RESOLUTION NO. 2017-09

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
SNOQUALMIE PASS UTILITY DISTRICT, KING AND KITTITAS
COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING AND APPROVING A
POLICY FOR WATER AND SEWER SERVICE TERMINATION; AND
RESCINDING AND SUPERSEDING ANY AND ALL PREVIOUS
RESOLUTIONS RELATING THERETO.**

WHEREAS, Snoqualmie Pass Utility District (“District”) is a water-sewer special purpose district providing water and sewer service pursuant to Title 57 Revised Code of Washington to the area generally known as the Snoqualmie Pass located in King and Kittitas County, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the District Board of Commissioners by the adoption of Resolution No. 2017-03 previously established water and sewer service rates and charges; and

WHEREAS, the established water service rates and charges included billing water base charges for all properties connected to the District’s water system regardless of the amount of water used; and

WHEREAS, RCW 57.08.005 (3) provides where a customer connected to the District's water system uses water on an intermittent or transient basis, a district may charge for providing water service to such customer, regardless of the amount of water, if any, used by the customer; and

WHEREAS, the District has received requests from customers who no longer need and desire to terminate District water service and eliminate the cost of water base charges; and

WHEREAS, the District is willing to allow customer who desire to terminate District water service on certain terms and conditions, including, if the customer receives District sewer service, such sewer service also be terminated; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Snoqualmie Pass Utility District, King and Kittitas County, Washington, as follows:

1. A customer may apply to the District to terminate a water and service account and District water and sewer service by completing and submitting an application for service termination in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and incorporated herein by this reference to the District.
2. The utility service account and water/sewer service termination shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:


- a. The customer shall be required to terminate both District water and sewer service to the property receiving such service.
- b. The customer applying for utility service termination shall not be entitled to any refund of any water or sewer connection charges previously paid to the District for utility service.
- c. The customer shall pay all District costs incurred to terminate and abandon the utility service account and the water/sewer service, including removing the water meter and capping and disconnecting the customer's water service line at the District water main, and capping the side sewer.
- d. The customer shall be entitled to receive a monetary credit of the cash value at time of application for water and sewer service termination in the amount of the cost of an equivalent residential unit ("ERU") associated with the meter size for a water general facility connection charge and the type of sewer service (residential, commercial, etc.), and such monetary credit shall be applied to the property for any future request for water and sewer service to the property.
- e. If the owner of the property for which District utility service was previously terminated applies to connect the property to the District's utility systems after such termination, and the District determines it has water available and sewer capacity to serve the property, the customer shall pay all then-applicable District water connection and meter charges, and sewer connection and side sewer charges, provided the property owner shall be entitled to receive the credits applicable to the property referenced above.
- f. At the time of the termination of the utility service account and utility service, the District shall record a notice at the customer's expense against the property regarding the terms and conditions of utility service termination and the conditions of possible future District utility service to the property as provided herein.

3. This resolution and the policies established herein shall be effective on the 10th day of April, 2017; all District resolutions, policies and procedures are hereby modified, superseded and/or rescinded to be in accordance with the policies adopted herein.



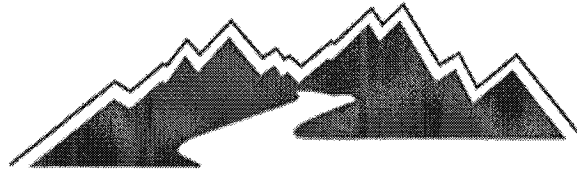
