

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Snoqualmie Pass Utility District invites separate sealed BIDS for the construction of the ALPENTAL AND DOT LIFT STATION UPGRADES, HLA Project No. 21060 including the following approximate major quantities of work:

Temporary bypass pumping and replacement of four dry pit submersible sewer lift station pumps, motors, and piping, including valves, fittings, wiring, electrical, and controls.

This contract has ten (10) working days to complete the work.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 a.m. on April 6, 2022, starting at the DOT Lift Station located at 61 Keechelus Boat Launch Road, Snoqualmie Pass, WA 98068. Bids from bidders who did not attend the mandatory pre-bid conference will not be accepted.

Bids will be received by the District Manager, in person or via shipping at 932 Hyak Drive (USPS deliver to PO BOX 131) , Snoqualmie Pass, WA 98068, until 1:00 p.m., April 20, 2022, and then shortly thereafter will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Each bid or proposal must be accompanied by bond or a certified check, payable to the order of the Treasurer of the Snoqualmie Pass Utility District for the sum of not less than 5% of said bid or proposal and none will be considered unless accompanied by such deposit, to be forfeited to the Snoqualmie Pass Utility District in the event the successful bidder shall fail or refuse to enter into a Contract with the City for the making and construction of the aforesaid improvement. All bids or proposals must be in writing on the form bound in the Specifications, sealed and filed with the Clerk on or before the day and hour above mentioned.
