**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
SNOQUALMIE PASS UTILITY DISTRICT, KING AND KITTITAS
COUNTIES, WASHINGTON, AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR
THE ALPENTAL & DOT LIFT STATION UPGRADES PROJECT
TO BOSS CONSTRUCTION INC.**

WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Pass Utility District (District) is a special purpose water-sewer district authorized and existing pursuant to Title 57 Revised Code of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the District Board of Commissioners authorized the Alpentel and DOT wastewater lift station upgrades project; and

WHEREAS, two bids were received and opened for the Lift Stations Upgrades project on June 7, 2022. The lowest responsible bidder is BOSS Construction Inc. at a cost of \$496,672.03; and

WHEREAS, General Manager Hastings and HLA Engineering have recommended that the Board award the contract for the Lift Stations Upgrades project to BOSS Construction Inc. at a cost of \$496,672.03, being the lowest and most responsible bid received; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of the District to award the contract for the Lift Stations Upgrades project to BOSS Construction Inc. at a cost of \$496,672.03; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Snoqualmie Pass Utility District, King and Kittitas Counties, Washington, as follows:


1. Award the contract for the Alpentel & DOT Wastewater Lift Station Upgrades project to BOSS Construction Inc. at a cost of \$496,672.03.
2. The District General Manager is authorized and directed to work with the District's consulting engineer and the District's legal counsel to prepare any documents needed to finalize the awarding of the contract for the Lift Station Upgrade project to BOSS Construction Inc. at a cost of \$496,672.03, and the District General Manager is further authorized and directed to sign any such documents to effectuate the same.
